The Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF) establishes a clear alignment with the 2050 Vision of "Living in Harmony with Nature".

The GBF includes 4 overarching global goals and 23 targets, of which Targets 8 and 11 specifically link biodiversity with increasing resilience through mitigation, adaptation, and Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) actions, including through Nature-based Solutions (NbS) and/or Ecosystem-based Approaches. The aim of this webinar is to present the importance of these targets as well as the possibility of integrating the GBF with relevant frameworks.
